

## **Halsey Stevens**

The Reverend Halsey "Chip" Stevens III, 78, of Bloomfield and formerly of Killingworth, beloved husband of Betsey (Nash) Stevens, and retired Episcopal Priest of the Episcopal Church of Connecticut, died Monday, January 15, 2018. Born in Hartford, son of the late Halsey and Margaret (Chapin) Stevens, Jr. he was raised in Windsor where he graduated from Windsor High School and worshiped at Grace Episcopal Church.

He received his BA from Nasson College, Springvale, ME and his Masters in Divinity from the now Berkley at Yale Divinity School, New Haven. He truly was gifted as a pastoral counselor and enjoyed that part of his ministry.
